

10 THINGS TO DO WITH A CAR

1. Take the scenic drive to nearby Lough Navar, and you will reach a dramatic cliff-top viewing point with a sweeping view across Lough Erne to the distant Donegal Mountains.
2. Stop off at Portora Royal School and Castle where Old Boys included Oscar Wilde and Samuel Beckett.
3. Visit the Marble Arch Caves European Geopark – one of Europe's finest show caves – and explore a fascinating natural underworld of rivers, waterfalls, winding passages and lofty chambers.
4. Tour the Lough MacNea Sculpture Trail. Situated along the boundaries of Fermanagh, Cavan and Leitrim, this 40-mile circular trail of unique sculptures, created by renowned Irish artists.
5. Lose yourself in the natural beauty of Crom Estate – one of The National Trust's most important nature reserves. A romantic and tranquil landscape of islands, woodland and historical ruins.
6. Monea Castle - Built for Malcolm Hamilton and completed in 1618, it has a Scottish look about it, with corner turrets at one narrow end of a rectangular four-storey building and with two massive full-height round towers having angular tops guarding the entrance.
7. Take a trip to Inish Rath Island – home of the Krishna Spiritual Community. Peacocks, herons, swans, deer, squirrels and hares inhabit this peaceful island, where woodland walks give way to rolling lawns leading up to an elegant Victorian stately house.
8. Drive the stunning circuit around Lower Lough Erne taking in Belleek, Kesh, Irvinestown and return to the resort via Enniskillen. Stop off enroute at Lusty Beg Island for lunch.
9. Breathe in the Atlantic air at one of the Donegal Coast's beautiful blue flag beaches.
10. Visit the Ulster American Folk Park – an open-air museum in Co Tyrone – which tells the story of emigration from Ulster to America in the 18th & 19th centuries and provides visitors with a "living history" experience on its outdoor site. Costumed demonstrators go about their everyday tasks in the traditional manner in authentically furnished Old and New World buildings.

10 THINGS TO DO IN THE SUNSHINE

1. Discover the magic of the Fermanagh Lakelands and surrounding counties by air. Helicopter and Seaplane tours can be booked in advance through Guest Relations.
2. Put your walking boots on and explore Fermanagh by foot. Climb to the top of the Magho Cliffs and enjoy breathtaking views across Lower Lough Erne, marvel at the panoramic views of Lower and Upper Lough MacNea, Florencecourt and Cuilcagh Mountain or explore the Cladagh Glen. 3. Get on your bike! Fermanagh is part of The National Cycle Network with routes varying from traffic-free and family-friendly to challenging and long-distance. Visit www.cycletoursireland.com and www.northwest-trail.com
4. Check out Castle Archdale Country Park with its woodland & lakeshore walks, boat hire, natural history exhibits, Castle Archdale at War exhibition on the Battle of the Atlantic.
5. Visit White Island. The main feature of the ruined 12th-century church is its fine Romanesque doorway. The archaic stone figures set into the wall pre-date the church. Passenger ferry from Castle Archdale Country Park.
6. Explore Florence Court – a National Trust property surrounded by a large area of parkland, garden and woodland, with breathtaking views to Benaughlin and the Cuilcagh Mountains.
7. Take a trip on the MV Kestrel – A 56-seater traditional, fully glazed waterbus offering guided tours and dinner cruises. Traversing Lower Lough Erne, an island stop off at Devenish Island Monastic Site is included. The island is famous for its perfect 12th-century round tower and ruined Augustinian abbey.
8. Dine alfresco on our beautiful terrace overlooking Castle Hume Lough
9. Book a private heritage and cultural tour of the local area with an experienced guide. This can be booked in advance through Guest Relations.
10. Hire a boat at Castle Archdale Country Park marina, take a picnic and have lunch on an island
