For babies to a massaging cot plus a complete bath set is provided. At turndown on the first night children will find a Lough Erne swan on their pillow.

Cygnets has been created by professionals to guarantee fun for all the family. The programme promises to keep Lough Erne Golf Resort's younger guests entertained for hours – from daily swim-



time with mum or dad, myriad of outdoor activities, board games – allowing parents some time to escape to the spa, go for a sail, play a round of golf, or join in the fun.
