Set on a 600-acre peninsula between Castle Hume Lough and Lower Lough Erne, the Resort opens up one of the most untouched areas of North West Ireland – the Fermanagh Lakelands. At the heart of the region is the magnificent Lough Erne, the jewel in Fermanagh's crown and home to some of Europe's best fly fishing. Resident Ghillie, Patrick Trotter, one of only 140 Master Casting Instructors in the world, expertly navigates the waters, sharing the secrets of the lough and taking guests to the best spots for brown trout, pike and coarse fish.

The region is renowned for deer stalking and the team at Lough Erne can arrange an exclusive day's deer stalking at the nearby Colebrooke Estate. With shooting rights stretching over 7,000 acres, the terrain varies from lowland grasslands to large conifer woods to heather clad hills, and is home to all of Ireland's deer species: Sika, Fallow and Red Deer. Personally supervised by Lord Brookeborough, this is an unforgettable experience.

Executive Head Chef, Noel McMeel, is dedicated to sourcing the best local, seasonal produce and his philosophy is to provide guests with inspiring and memorable cuisine. All seasonal menus have been created by McMeel: from à la carte dining in The Catalina Restaurant to chocolate afternoon teas in The Garden Hall; light meals in The Drawing Room; and a grazing-style menu in The Blaney Bar. The extensive wine list has been carefully selected by Jane Boyce MW, the only Master of Wine residing in Northern Ireland, and The Blaney Bar stocks the 71 Irish whiskies ever produced.

For luxurious pampering and restorative treatments, The Thai Spa is a haven. The spa is the only wholly authentic Thai spa experience in the UK, with five Thai therapists, Thai treatments and Thai products, Lau Erb. The Resort has one championship golf course and in summer 2009, The Faldo Championship Course will open.

Lough Erne Golf Resort has 120 guestrooms, including 25 two- and three-bedroom Luxury Lakeside Lodges, which offer private fully-serviced accommodation. The Resort is located just five minutes from Enniskillen (St Angelo) private airport, and is easily accessible from Belfast International and Belfast City airports. The Resort has five helicopter pads, an exclusive 4x4 Land Rover car hire service (Range Rover, Range Rover Sport, Land Rover Discovery and Freelander 2 are available) and can arrange limousine transfer.

Lough Erne Golf Resort's Luxury Lakeside Lodges are priced from £260 per night for a two-bedroom property which sleeps four people, and from £390 per night for a three-bedroom property. Half-day fly fishing from £85.00, a day's deer stalking from £290 per person, green fees from £95.00, three course dinner in The Catalina Restaurant starts from £39.50, and signature treatments in The Thai Spa from £39.
