



### WHAT MAKES LOUGH ERNE RESORT...

- The finest Irish linen, wood burning fireplaces and a glass of Irish whiskey – Lough Erne combines traditional Irish charm with world class facilities and state-of-the-art technology
- From *à la carte* dining in The Catalina Restaurant or The Loughside Bar & Grill, to Chocolate Afternoon Teas in The Garden Hall, light meals in The Drawing Room and The Grazing Menu in The Blaney Bar - seasonal menus created by Acclaimed Chef, Noel McMeel draw upon fresh, home grown, locally-sourced ingredients
- The Halfway House (Open April 2010) & Seafood Experience (Open May 2010) situated behind the ninth green of The Faldo Course, with stunning views overlooking Lough Erne –Menu items include: hand-dived scallops, oysters from Strangford Lough and fresh fish bought in that morning to Killybegs
- The Thai Spa - a totally Thai experience - with eight treatment rooms including a dual treatment room and a specialist Thai massage suite. The therapists all originate and are fully trained in Thailand
- The Thai Spa uses Lau Erb products developed using traditional Thai remedies gleaned from ancient manuscripts under the guidance of traditional Thai herbalist gurus using pure natural ingredients – cinnamon, ylang ylang, tamarind, black pepper...
- An indoor Infinity pool – a giant lotus flower mosaic dresses the end wall and, to one side, floor-to-ceiling arched windows look out over Castle Hume Lough
- Two championship golf courses – the world class Faldo Course, designed by Nick Faldo which opened in July 2009 and Castle Hume Course.
- Get down to business in the fully-equipped business centre, or relax by the open fire in The Gordon Wilson Library
- 6 Conference & Meeting Spaces, seating from 12 - 400 persons, all rooms are flooded with natural daylight and have views of Castle Hume Lough and The Faldo Course
- Lough Erne - one of Europe's most tranquil stretches of inland water - measures 25 miles and has 365 islands - a playground for water sports and fly fishing.
- Travel further afield and explore Co. Donegal's dramatic coastline by seaplane, stop to enjoy a gourmet picnic hamper provided by Noel McMeel and his brigade on some of the most beautiful beaches in the world...
